Computer Driving Licence (ICDL) concepts, which are the world's most popular basic ICT skills

certifications. ECDL Foundation's certification programmes have been delivered to over 11 million people,

in 41 languages, across 148 countries, through a network of over 24,000 test centres. Between 1 million and

1.5 million students enroll on the programme every year through a network of partner institutions and

national governing bodies appointed by the Foundation.

ECDL Foundation works with communities, local and regional authorities, national governments, NGOs,

international bodies such as the United Nations Headquarters, World Bank, Asian Development Bank, UNDP

(United Nations Development Programme), UNESCO CWR, UNHCR (United Nations High Commissioner

for Refugees), UNRWA (United Nations Relief and Works Agency -Jordan, Lebanon, Syria, Palestine),

USAID (United States Agency for International Development Aid), UNAIDS, CAMARA Education, World

Health Organization (WHO Congo), in the delivery of its ICT skills certification programmes around the world.

In 2001, ECDL Foundation appointed UNESCO Cairo Office to promote computer literacy in the MENA
